PERFECT

FORM (*Oblika*)

have/has + past participle /-ed

- ▶ I **have been** to Rome. / He **has been** to Rome.
- ▶ I **haven't been** to Rome. / He **hasn't been** to Rome.
- ▶ **Have** you **been** to Rome? / **Has** he **been** to Rome?
- ▶ When **have** I **been** to Rome? / When **has** he **been** to Rome?

USE (uporaba)

Present perfect uporabljamo:

- ▶ *za opis dogodkov ali izkušenj v preteklosti, kadar časa ne povemo.*
- ▶ *ko govorimo o dogodkih, ki so se zgodili **do zdaj**.*
- ▶ *za opis dogodkov, ki so se začeli v preteklosti in še vedno trajajo.*
- ▶ *za opis sedanje posledice preteklega dejanja.*

Prislovna določila, ki jih uporabljamo s časom present perfect so:

- **JUST** (*ravnokar*)
- **EVER** (*do zdaj*)
- **NEVER** (*nikoli*)
- **ALREADY** (*že*)
- **YET** /-, ?/ (*ne še*)
- **SINCE** (*od*)
- **FOR** (*toliko časa*)
- **RECENTLY** (*pred kratkim*)
- **STILL, ANY MORE**

1. Present perfect + JUST

- ▶ *The football has just started.*

Present perfect + just uporabimo za izražanje nečesa, kar se je pravkar zgodilo.
