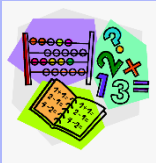

THE HISTORY OF THE OLYMPICS



THE ANCIENT OLYMPICS

- historians think that the first Olympic Games were in 776 BC in town Olympia
- athletes from Greece
- one event – running race called the »stade«
- Coroebes of Elis-first Olympic champion; cook
- more events (wrestling, horse races)
- athletes were men, they competed without clothes
- every four years
- in 394 Roman Emperor Theodosius stopped them for religious reasons

THE MODERN OLYMPICS

- Frenchman Pierre de Coubertin wanted to restart the Olympic Games in 1887
- in April 1896 were first modern Olympic Games
- 13 countries, 300 competitors, 9 different sports
- Olympic rings: - designed by Pierre de Coubertin
 - every ring represent different continents
- TODAY:
 - the most famous sports competition
 - every four years in a different city
 - in 2004 were in Athens; over 11.000 athletes from 203 countries; 28 different sports
