Still or any more ?

STILL is used to show that *an action is happening (or not) up to this day. It hasn't changed or stopped:*

I still live in the same small town.

ANY MORE is used to show that *something has finished or the situation has changed:*

I don't go to school any more.

Craig: I still love Winnipeg, but I don't miss it any more.
